TENNIS LEADER AWARDS

Tennis Leaders is targeted at 14 – 16 year olds with an interest in tennis.

Tennis Leaders has been updated. The course content has been expanded to include other aspects of tennis volunteering – to encourage more young people to get involved and encourage volunteering in off court tennis activities. There is now a clear distinction between Tennis Leaders and the Level 1 Coaching Assistant Course.

There are 4 modules in the Tennis Leaders Award:

MODULE

1



Planning, Organisation and Communication

3 hours plus 6 hours volunteering experience

- Understand the importance of planning.
- Recognise and be able to use effective communication skills.
- Understand the importance of good organisation on and off court.
- Put your skills into practice.

MODULE

2



Club media and communications

2 hours plus 6 hours volunteering experience

- Understand why media and communications are important to the development of your club.
- Be able to assist with/be responsible for media and communication tasks within the club.

MODULE

3



Playing partner/buddy hitting

2 hours plus 6 hours volunteering experience

- Know the attributes of a good buddy hitter.
- Know how to feed appropriately.
- Understand the 5 game situations of singles.
- Learn how to feed in game based situations.

MODULE

4



Competition assistant

2 hours 30 mins plus 6 hours volunteering experience

- Understand why competition is important.
- Be able to assist your coach, club organiser or referee at a local tournament.
- Gain confidence and knowledge of the competition framework.
