

## **SERVES REGIONAL COORDINATOR – LONDON**

The Tennis Foundation is Great Britain's leading tennis charity; our vision is a sport which is inclusive and accessible to every kind of community.

SERVES is a community-based programme designed by the Tennis Foundation to tackle some of the issues faced by people in disadvantaged communities, such as high levels of unemployment, poor health prospects, physical inactivity and low self-esteem. It does this by bringing tennis into the heart of these communities, giving young people the chance to develop valuable life skills, both on and off the tennis court, which in turn builds their confidence, health and employment prospects.

It is supported by Sport England, and works in partnership with the Lawn Tennis Association (LTA) as well as other key stakeholders including but not limited to StreetGames, SportED and Sporting Equals.

The role of the SERVES Regional Coordinator for London is to support the operational delivery of the programme. Strong communication and influencing will be essential to develop and maintain relationships with key London based partners to ensure effective delivery of the SERVES operational plan and strategy. Key to this role will be an understanding of the social impact of sport, have knowledge of the sporting landscape in London and knowledge of tennis would be desirable.
