

## National Wheelchair Tennis Series Ranking System 2017

In conjunction with the Disability Competitions Manager, each Tournament Organiser and Referee will set the draw sizes dependant on the number of players entered and their skill level.

All Tournaments must run a Novice category for beginner players in which points will not be accumulated.

Tournaments with enough entries to run a main draw and a second draw are encouraged to do so to ensure players all have competition that is appropriate to them. Where there is a main draw and a second draw, the points for the second draw are listed across. Where there is one draw only the 'Main draw' points will be used.

Ranking Points will be awarded to players that have received a bye, but lose their first match in a knock-out event.

Ranking Points will not be awarded for any consolation matches, however Tournament Organisers are encouraged to run consolation if time permits.

Doubles ranking points are listed on the next page. The points listed are per player. Players from the Novice category are permitted to play in main draw doubles.

### Seeding

Where a knock-out format is used, a seeding system should be employed (singles and Doubles). How many seeds you have will depend on the size of the draw:

6 - 8 Players = 2 seeds

9 - 16 Players = 4 seeds

The seeds should be established by discussion between the Disability Competitions Manager, Tournament Organiser and Referee. A decision will be made on the basis of shared knowledge of the players competing (their relative skill level and experience), in conjunction with points and positions from previous rounds.

Doubles points are awarded to each player. Players are permitted to play in doubles only if they do not wish to play in Singles. Novice singles players are permitted to play in main draw doubles. It is at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser and Referee if the singles main draw and second draws are combined for doubles.
