

## 2018 Regional Series Learning Disability Points System

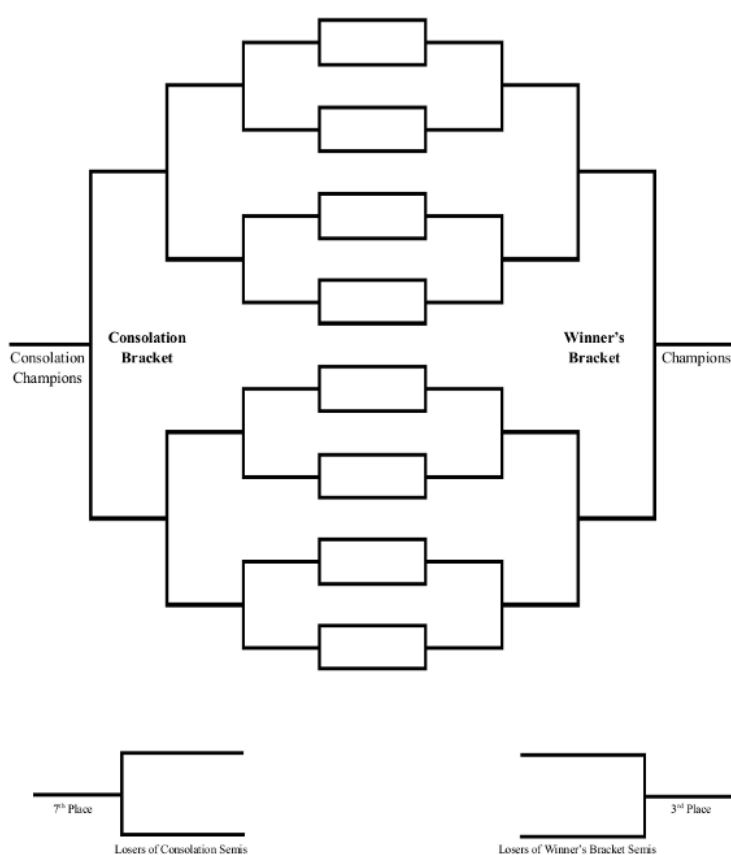
*The point's system will only apply to those athletes who play with a yellow hard ball. Orange and green ball players will play in round robin formats with a winner of each division.*

There will be three formats for yellow ball as, discussed in the email, which tournament organisers can choose to run their tournament with.

### **OPTION 1: Yellow ball players split into one or two compass draws**

A compass draw guarantees players a minimum of two matches. If a player wins their first match they will move forward in the draw. If they lose their first match they will move backwards into a consolation draw.

Example of a 16 player compass draw, these can also be done with 8 players or less



### POINTS

#### **Division 1 Compass Draw (6-16 players)**

#### **Division 2 Compass Draw (6-16 players)**

## OPTION 2: Round Robin Format

This is the format we have used in the past. Players are split into numerous round robin divisions. There is a winner in each division.

### POINTS

#### Round Robins

## OPTION 3: Combination of a compass draw and Round Robins

Division 1 will be played as a compass draw and the remaining yellow ball divisions will be played as round robins.

### POINTS

#### Division 1 Compass Draw (6-16 players)

#### Division 2+ Round Robins

**RULES TO NOTE:**

- There will be two prizes awarded at the end of the year:
  1. “Regional Series Winner” - points will be averaged over all tournaments that a player has entered.
  2. “Most Tournaments Entered” this prize will be given to the player who has attended the most competitions.
  
- The points will be used to help form the divisions at Nationals, however only players who have played in division 1 at regional level will be considered for division 1 at nationals.
