Singles Sign-In: Sign-in with Tournament Referee by 16.00 on Monday 18 February. Draw will follow.

Doubles Sign-In: Sign-in with the Tournament Referee by 12.00 on Tuesday 19 February.

Consolation deadline: Players who wish to play in consolation draw must sign in with the referee if they lose in the first round.

Finals: All finals are scheduled to take place on Saturday 23 February. This may change at the discretion of the referee and tournament director.

Official Hotel: Premier Inn Bolton Arena (directly across the road from Tennis Courts)

Transport: Transport to and from Manchester airport will be offered for **flights arriving and departing between 8am – 10pm** on Sunday 17 and Monday 18 February and returning on Saturday 23 February. For Sunday 24 February transport will be available for flights between 8am – 2pm. Players must arrange & pay for their own transport outside of these hours.

Transfer Time: Manchester airport – 40 minutes (approximate)

Format: Men's, Ladies & Quad singles main draw matches – best of 3 tie-break sets*

Consolation and doubles matches: 2 tie-break sets; third set match tie-break*

Entry Fees: Entry fee accommodation package includes 5 nights' bed and breakfast (check in Monday 18 - check out Saturday 23 February) and airport transfer. 5 days lunch are included for all players and coaches.
