The Post

The University of Stirling, Scotland's University for Sporting Excellence, seeks an enthusiastic graduate to combine tennis development, co-ordination, leadership and coaching in a higher education setting whilst studying for a higher degree. The post is part-funded by the Tennis Foundation.

Primary responsibilities include the delivery of a comprehensive tennis programme to students and staff, the development of tennis opportunities for players of all standards and to provide direction and guidance to the student tennis club - a leading club within the University's Sports Union. The post-holder will help co-ordinate student competitive tennis teams, develop tennis participation opportunities and seek additional ways to support student involvement within the sport. Close collaboration with our stakeholders including the Tennis Foundation and Tennis Scotland is an important feature of the role. The post-holder is expected to study part-time (2-years) for a postgraduate degree in a role-related academic discipline, the fees for which are paid for by the University's Sports Development Service.
