

# Student Ball Crew Offer

In its 29<sup>th</sup> year, the 2018 British Open Wheelchair Tennis Championships will run from 17-22 July. It is one of only six 'Super Series' events around the world and is part of the UNIQLO Wheelchair Tennis Tour featuring around 60 men, women and quad division players plus 30 juniors. The event is one of the most important tournaments in the world outside the Grand Slams and will feature Grand Slam and Paralympic champions and medallists.

## BALL CREW OFFER

We are looking for students to take part in the event as ball crew. We understand that this is a large commitment but we truly believe the benefits that students can get from being part of this event and activities surrounding it are huge.

We aim to develop students' leadership skills, confidence and independence through our ball crew programme, run by professional trainers.

### The Offer

- 3 days of training in the run up to the event (**Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> May, Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> July and Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> July; most likely 10.00-13.00pm\***)  
All training would take place at Nottingham Tennis Centre.
- The event runs from the 17-22 July (6 days). Teams will work in shifts across the whole event which will be confirmed once training has been completed.
  - Each student will require a responsible adult for drop-off and pick-up during training and event days.

They will be provided with clothing and lunches on site.  
Squads are formed of 7 students.
